



CryoUsers 2026 Travel & Registration Instructions

Car

The University's campuses are located from just 1 mile to the nearest motorway junction and there are University signposts directing you to the campuses. The M60 outer ring road connects to all the motorways running into Manchester from north, south, east and west.

Parking is limited on campus and is restricted around the halls of residence, so we would recommend car parks B, D & E which are listed on the following link

It is a 20-minute walk to Schuster from St Anselms, or a 4-minute bus ride (operated by Bee Network which run every 10-minutes; lines 53 & 50, £2 per ticket available on the bus)

Here are some options for travel to Manchester:

Air

Manchester International Airport is located just 10 miles from the city centre with a direct train service into Manchester Piccadilly Train Station every 20 minutes throughout the week. Train and tram tickets start from £2.90 for a single journey booked in advance and the journey time is 18 minutes. Alternatively, you can get a taxi to the city centre from the airport for around £30. To get more detailed and comprehensive information about flying into Manchester

Train

Most major cities across the UK offer direct train services into Manchester Piccadilly Train Station, which is a 15-minute walk to the Oxford Road Campus or a short taxi ride. For details of prices and timetables of all national train connections into Manchester, visit Trainline

TransPennine Express <https://www.tpexpress.co.uk/> operates direct train services into Manchester from across the north of England, Edinburgh and Glasgow and direct services into the city centre from Manchester Airport.

Taxi

A taxi to the city centre from the airport costs around £30.

Walk

The Oxford Road Campus is a 15-minute walk from Manchester Piccadilly Train Station, go to Google Maps <https://www.google.co.uk/maps/> to plan your route.
