

EXPERIMENTAL APPLIED SCIENCE PRIZE



The Harry Jones Prize

Awarded Annually by the British Cryogenics Council

Deadline: 30 September

The prize is for research in the area of experimental applied science

Free membership for the BCC for 2 years

Student Prize £250

Eligibility: Undergraduate students who have completed a research project in their final year, or postgraduate students who have completed their Master's research project, 1st year report or Doctoral thesis in the preceding 24 months are eligible.

A significant component of the research must include Cryogenics. The prize is awarded by the Chair of the British Cryogenics Council after considering the recommendation by the supervisor and the quality and relevance of the student's research. The prize is worth £250 for the student. It also provides free membership of the British Cryogenics Council for 2 years for both the student and the supervisor.

Application process

The case for support should include a one page letter of support from the research supervisor explaining why the student has been nominated and an electronic version of the student's report. These two documents should be sent electronically to the Secretary of the BCC on or before the 30th September: admin@bcryo.org.uk
